RaiseUp Study

If you have narcolepsy with cataplexy (also known as narcolepsy type 1), you may be eligible to participate in research.

About the RaiseUp Study

The purpose of the RaiseUp Study is to evaluate the safety and effectiveness of an investigational study drug in the treatment of adults who have narcolepsy type 1 (NTI). This study may help researchers understand how the body processes the investigational study drug and how it may affect excessive daytime sleepiness (EDS).

Who Can Participate?

Eligible participants must:

- ▲ Be 18 to 70 years of age
- ▲ Have received an NTI diagnosis within the past 10 years or are experiencing NTI symptoms (characterized by cataplexy, or the sudden loss of muscle control and muscle weakness due to strong emotions or actions, like anger or laughter, while remaining conscious)
- ▲ Be willing to stop any current NT1 treatment
